COUNCIL COMMENTS

Channel Bay Project (Windfare Condominiums)

Since Council approval of Phase I of the Channel Bay Project, the site plan has been amended to reduce the project by one duplex. This revision was submitted to meet new CAMA rules regarding setback requirements. The question before Council is if this amended plan is a significant enough of an amendment to require the review process to start over at Phase 1 approval. It was the consensus that this is a significant enough of a change to require the developer to submit for Phase 1 approval again.

West End Ditch

Property owners in this area are requesting the Town assist with their drainage issues. One thing the Town can do is clean out the west end drainage ditch. The Town's only requirement is to keep the streets clear, not private property. Staff is requesting direction whether to seek bids and proceed.

Mayor Pro Tem Porter proposes a meeting with the homeowners to provide them with a timeline and assistance the Town is willing to provide. Mayor Cooper will speak with Ron Cullipher about a timeline and then speak to the property owners.

There being no further action taken or business before Council the meeting stood adjourned. The time was 12:35pm.
