3:45 p.m.**

- Duke Energy has begun restoring power to the majority of Atlantic Beach as of 2:30 p.m. today. Please note that **Carteret Craven EMC, serves some of our residents in the west end of town.**
- There are still downed cable and phone lines in some areas of Atlantic Beach, please drive with caution and stay clear of downed lines.
- We have deployed stormwater pumps throughout our town and many of our main stormwater pump stations are now back in service.
- Town Hall is closed. For non-emergency Public Works services please call (252) 726-1911.
- All Town Departments are working tirelessly to restore services as soon as possible.
- Electricity is still in the process of being fully restored to all Bogue Banks Towns. We will issue a final notice later as to the status of a curfew in place for tonight.
- We ask that citizens continue to be conservative with the use of water until further notice.
- We hope all our local and part-time residents weathered the storm safely and can now return to Atlantic Beach. Enjoy your weekend!
