**Update 4: Tuesday, September 3, 2019
2:00pm**

- Governor Cooper has called for a **MANDATORY EVACUATION** of the barrier islands, **including Bogue Banks**, to commence Wednesday, September 4 at 8:00am.
- In cooperation with the State of North Carolina and Carteret County Emergency Management, Mayor Trace Cooper has issued a **Mandatory Evacuation** effective 8:00am on Wednesday, September 4, 2019 for the Town of Atlantic Beach .
- Atlantic Beach encourages all our residents and visitors to be in a safe place and sheltered **by 10:00am Thursday, September 5**, at which time tropical force winds are expected to increase substantially here.
- Residents, businesses, and guests should take action now to protect their property and prevent the unnecessary loss of life. Please leave early, especially those traveling with boats, RV's and/or trailers.
- We intend to keep Town Hall open all day Wednesday and suggest you **obtain your Re-Entry Pass by end of the business day**.
- Carteret County Schools have announced they will be closed September 4, 5 and 6th.
- We will announce other directives on any curfews established or bridge closings later, if the situation requires. **No decision on these two items has yet been made.**
