



# Hurricane Dorian

**Update 9: Friday, September 6, 2019  
10:30 a.m.**

- **The curfew put into effect last night will be lifted at 12:00 noon today.** At that time, access restrictions on the Atlantic Beach bridge will be lifted and all traffic will be allowed onto Atlantic Beach. Reentry passes will not be needed.
- Atlantic Beach remains without power. If power is not restored today, a curfew will likely be imposed again tonight. Stay tuned to official Atlantic Beach channels for updates.
- Until power is restored our water system will be significantly impaired. Use water **ONLY** for drinking, bathing and flushing toilets. **DO NOT use water for washing your homes, cars or boats.**
- Some roads remain flooded, please do not attempt to pass roads with significant standing water. Similarly, avoid any downed power lines.
